

STARK COUNTY BLUECOATS ENDOWMENT AND SCHOLARSHIP FUND

1. Type of Award: Scholarship
2. Eligibility: A member of the safety forces means police officer or Firefighter.
 - a. Dependent child of a member of the safety forces who was killed in the line of duty and who can demonstrate financial need; or
 - b. Dependent child of a member of the safety forces who has been injured or incapacitated by illness sustained in the line of duty and who can demonstrate financial need; or
 - c. Dependent child of a member of the safety forces who died prematurely other than in the line of duty and who can demonstrate financial need; or
 - d. Dependent child of a member of the safety forces who can demonstrate financial need; or
 - e. Surviving spouse or child of a member of the safety forces who is pursuing further education to enhance his/her income potential and/or job qualifications and skills and who can demonstrate financial need; or
 - f. Dependent child of a retired member of the safety forces
 - g. Member of the safety forces who is pursuing additional education in his/her own category of employment
 - h. Must attend or be planning to attend an accredited school or institution of higher learning
 - i. No member or relative of a member of the Selection Committee or of the Foundation's Board of Trustees is eligible to receive a scholarship award from the Fund
3. Criteria for Selection: Financial needs are considered, but all awards are at the discretion of the Selection Committee.
4. Renewable: Yes
5. Deadline for Application: April 15
6. Date of Awards: By June 15
7. Number and Amount of Awards: Varies
