Internet access



85.6% of households in Bethlehem Township have an **internet subscription**, compared to 86.1% in Stark County.



2.6% of households in Bethlehem Township have **internet access but no subscription**, compared to 4.5% in Stark County.



11.7% of households in Bethlehem Township have **no internet access**, compared to 9.4% in Stark County.
